The ranges for the week, in the 2000's, were about 139% of what they were in the 1970's, 198% of the 1980's and 144% of the 1990's. **The average range since 2000 is 14.00 cents.** Since 1970, the Highs have come on Monday 34% of the time and 11% on Thursday. The Lows have come on Tuesday 26% of the time and 13% on Thursday. Since 1970, prices have closed unchanged or lower 53% of the time in Week 18.
